Siebe Tettero graduated with a BA in Architecture and Industrial design from the Royal Academy of Arts, The Hague in 1982, a MA in Architecture from Columbia University, New York, in 1989, and a MA in Contemporary Art from The University of Manchester in 2003.

Tettero is art consultant and architect, Head of Tettero Art Consultants, with offices in New York and Amsterdam, the Netherlands. Prior to setting up his own company Tettero worked in several commercial and institutional capacities, amongst them director of modern and contemporary art at Sotheby's Amsterdam, head of interiors at the Rijksmuseum Amsterdam, as well as head of exhibitions at the Centraal Museum, Utrecht, the Netherlands.

Tettero advises private individuals and institutions on issues concerning the acquisition, presentation and preservation of modern and contemporary art, as architect he is leading noted residential renovations, and on occasion curates and designs exhibitions. Tettero Art Consultants was established in 2009. From 2009- 2014, he was also involved with the Metamatic Research Initiative, a not for profit foundation based in Amsterdam aiming to stimulate artistic and academic research into the work of Swiss French artist Jean Tinguely (1925-1991). Siebe Tettero is Board Member of Manifesta 12, the European contemporary art biennial, which will take place in Palermo Italy in 2018. Tettero is on the Board of Advisors of the Verbier | Art Untold Association which organises the Verbier | Summit in January 2017. The Verbier | Summit aims to ignite a global dialogue concerning issues of production, collection and representation of art.
